Unit 1: (1 month)

This unit focuses on: Understanding the 6 C's, the code of conduct, the CQC fundamental standards and policies in the work setting.

Unit 3: (1 month)

This unit focuses on: Understanding working relationships in care settings. Being able to work in partnership with others and working in ways that are agreed with the employer.

Unit 5: (1 month)

This unit focuses on: Responsibilities relating to health and safety, fire safety and accidents or sudden illnesses, how to reduce the spread of infection

Unit 7: (1 month)

This unit focuses on: Understanding how duty of care contributes to safe practice, addressing conflict or dilemma, responding to complaints and safeguarding adults

Units 9 - 12: (4 months)

Optional units from the diploma

Unit 2: (1 month)

This unit focuses on: Understanding what is required for competence in your work role. Being able to reflect on practice and evaluate own performance. Agreeing a personal development plan to develop knowledge skills, reflective practice and understanding

Unit 4: (1 month)

This unit focuses on: The importance of equality, diversity and inclusion, promoting person-centred approaches and the role of risk assessments in enabling a person-centred approach

Unit 6: (1 month)

This unit focuses on: Effective communication overcoming barriers to communication and handling information in care settings

Unit 8: (1 month)

This unit focuses on: Recognising signs of abuse, responding to suspected or alleged abuse, national and local context of safeguarding. Reducing the likelihood of abuse, reporting unsafe practices
