

MATHEMATICS FUNCTIONAL SKILLS

Functional Skills in Mathematics
Entry Level 1, 2, 3, Level 1 and Level 2

This qualification has three units:

- Number
- Measure, Shape and Space
- Handling Data

Entry level 1, 2 and 3 is assessed by 3 externally set exams. Level 1 and level 2 is assessed by 1 externally set 2 hour exam.

Delivery models:

- Fully remote delivery model - Entry level 1, 2, 3, level 1 and level 2 - N/A
- Blended delivery – Functional Skills Entry level 1,2 and 3 – N/A
- Blended delivery – Functional Skills level 1 and level 2 (20 weeks)

To determine which level can be studied, learners must undertake an initial assessment (25 minutes)

Blended delivery - Functional Skills Level 1 and 2 (20 weeks)

Following initial assessment the tutor will provide a username and password for the learner to access the ForSkills Learning Platform, where they will complete an online diagnostic assessment. An Individual Skills Plan (ISP) is created and learning materials are allocated via ForSkills. The tutor monitors learner progress via ForSkills and can provide additional materials via email and will provide the learner with a workbook to support learning offline. An ILP will be developed during the first meeting with the learner. Face to face support sessions are planned (minimum of 4) following completion of the diagnostic assessment, additional support is given via email/phone.

This qualification is assessed by one externally, 2 hour exam.

Intense Delivery (classroom based) (45 hours (3hrs x 15 days / 3 weeks)) - Entry level 1,2, 3, level 1 and level 2 Functional Skills in Mathematics

Entry level 1, 2 and 3 - Following the initial assessment the learner will complete a diagnostic assessment and the tutor will create an ILP with the learner. Delivery will take place over a period of 3 weeks with the learner attending for 3 hours per day. Learners will complete an additional 15 hours of directed study using materials provided by the tutor.


Level 1 and level 2 - Following initial assessment the tutor will provide a username and password for the learner to access the ForSkills Learning Platform, where they will complete an online diagnostic assessment. An Individual Skills Plan (ISP) is created and learning materials are allocated via ForSkills. Delivery will take place over a period of 3 weeks with the learner attending for 3 hours per day. Learners will complete an additional 15 hours of directed study using materials provided by the tutor or by accessing the ForSkills learning platform.

This qualification is assessed by one externally set 2 hour exam.

Classroom delivery (30 hours (1.5 hrs x 20 weeks)(3 hrs x 10 weeks)) -Entry level 1, 2, 3, level 1 and level 2 Functional Skills in Mathematics

Entry level 1, 2 and 3 - Following the initial assessment the learner will complete a diagnostic assessment and the tutor will create an ILP with the learner. Delivery will take place over a period of 20/10 weeks with the learner attending for 1.5/3 hours per week. Learners will complete an additional 15 hours of directed study using materials provided by the tutor.

Level 1 and level 2 - Following initial assessment the tutor will provide a username and password for the learner to access the ForSkills Learning Platform, where they will complete an online diagnostic assessment. An Individual Skills Plan (ISP) is created and learning materials are allocated via ForSkills. Delivery will take place over a period of 20/10 weeks with the learner attending for 1.5/3 hours per week. Learners will complete an additional 15 hours of directed study using materials provided by the tutor or by accessing the ForSkills learning platform. This qualification is assessed by one externally set 2 hour exam.



Level 1 Certificate in Mathematics

This qualification has three units:

- Number
- Measure, Shape and Space
- Handling Data

The learner is provided with learning materials and an assessment booklet to complete. Units 1, 2 and 3 are completed by the learner and submitted to the tutor to mark.

Blended delivery – Level 1 certificate in Mathematics (15 weeks)

The learner is allocated a tutor who will make contact and complete an ILP following discussion with the learner using the outcome of the Initial Assessment. The learner is provided with learning materials and an assessment booklet to complete units 1 and 2 which are then submitted to the tutor to mark. Unit 3 is assessed via a face-to-face assessment of speaking and listening by the tutor. Support is delivered via email/phone and support sessions (minimum of 4).

Classroom delivery – Level 1 certificate in Mathematics (3hrs x 6 weeks/1.5 hours 12 weeks)

The tutor will develop an ILP with the learners. The learner is provided with learning materials and an assessment booklet to complete, units 1 and 2 which are submitted to the tutor to mark as the course progresses.

Intense delivery – Level 1 certificate in Mathematics (2 days)

The tutor will develop an ILP with the learners. The learner is provided with learning materials and an assessment booklet to complete, units 1 and 2 which are submitted to the tutor to mark as the course progresses.
